Application Instructions

Complete the application in your own handwriting and return it with the non-refundable application fee and a recent photo of yourself. Attach additional pages as necessary.

On your application, please supply the names and addresses of three personal references. The first is a minister at your church. The second is a person under whose supervision you have worked, such as a teacher or employer. The third reference should be an elder, Christian mentor, or friend who knows you well. Upon receipt of your application, our Admissions Office will send reference questionnaires to all three references to complete and return at their convenience.

Transcripts

The admissions process is not complete for degree seeking students until all official transcripts have been received. Official transcripts must come directly from the issuing high school or college to the Admissions Office at LBC. If you have questions about how to request transcripts from other institutions, we will be glad to give you the guidance you need.

New Freshman (never attended college): Request that your high school send an official transcript to Louisville Bible College. If you are currently in high school, please understand that we will need an additional transcript following your graduation to confirm your cumulative grade point average and graduation date. If you did not graduate from high school, please submit your GED scores in lieu of a high school transcript.

Transfer Student: Request that each college you have previously attended send official transcripts to Louisville Bible College. If you have completed less than 32 hours of college coursework, you will also need to request an official transcript from your high school, or submit verification of your GED scores.

Graduate Student: Request that the college that granted your undergraduate degree send an official transcript to Louisville Bible College. Request that official transcripts of any graduate level coursework you have completed be sent as well.
