REGENTS CALL NEW PRESIDENT



The Board of Regents of Louisville Bible College has called Dr. Tracy W. Marx to be the Seventh President in the sixty-one year history of the college. Dr. Marx has more than fifteen years experience in preaching, teaching, and Biblical counseling. He is presently the Preaching/Teaching Minister of Princeton Christian Church, Princeton, Indiana. Dr. Marx is married to Angela and they have three children: Reagan (9 years), Patrick (6 years), and Zoe (3 years).

He has earned the degrees *Bachelor of Science (Johnson Bible College)*, *Master of Divinity (Emmanuel School of Religion)*, and *Doctor of Ministry (Trinity Theological Seminary)*. He has also conducted *Doctor of Theology* work in Biblical Studies.

Dr. Marx is a Graduate Teacher with the Evangelical Training Association and serves on the distance learning assessment faculty with the South African Theological Seminary in Rivonia, South Africa. Dr. Marx's teaching and character have been endorsed by Dr. David L. Eubanks (President Emeritus, Knoxville, TN) and Dr. C. Robert Wetzel (President Emeritus, Johnson City, TN), among others.

Dr. Marx will begin his duties with the college March 1, 2010. The Interim President from January 1— February 28, 2010 is Gary Fenner. Mr. Fenner is a member of the Board of Regents and is the Preaching Minister of Calvary Christian Church, Sellersburg, Indiana.
